### <u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths, the class focused on addition and subtraction, revising the various ways to solve sums. The children used cubes, Numicon and other resources to help work out the answers to a variety of calculations.

#### **Topic**

The children studied how they had changed since they were babies. Thanks to the parents that sent in photos of their child as a baby – it was great to see the hugely noticeable changes. The children explained how they had visibly changed – hair, teeth, body size – and how they will continue to change as they grow older.
