Dear Parents,

The children have had a busy week this during our Storytelling week.

English

The children performed in a workshop by the West End in Schools 'Bringing Books to Life' organisation. The children participated in brining 'The Gangsta Granny' by David Walliams to life through drama and dance. The children this week enjoyed their time reading to Year 1 children. The children were paired with a Year 1 child and read to them a selection of picture books. This was a lovely opportunity for the children to practise reading from expression. This week we continued our work with our class novel: The Boy and the Bear in a Boat. The children discovered that one of the bear's sandwiches escaped. The children story boxed their plot for their writing and planned the language they were going to include. The children have begun writing their stories which will then be uplevelled next week.

Maths

In Maths this week the children have continued and finalised their work on area and perimeter. The children have been introduced to finding the area and perimeter of composite shapes. The children have learnt how to separate the shape to order to calculate the overall area. The children have also been introduced to estimating the area of irregular shapes through counting squares. The children applied this knowledge to comparing the size of Puerto Rico and Jamaica.

Other Areas of the Curriculum

This week the children went on their exciting trip around London! The children visited the Bank of England, Goldsmith Hall and Guidhall. The children were exposed to beautiful views and learnt about the geography and history of London from our amazing blue badge tour guide.

Jewish Studies

The main focus in Jewish Studies this week has been Parashat hashavua. In Mishpatim, we learnt the Mitzvah of not following the crowd to do evil (Shemot 23:2) and we discussed some examples from Tanach and modern times as well as ways in which we can apply this to our own lives. Children also continued working on their Chumash revision by writing letters from the eved to Avraham and they continued to prepare for the Shabbaton assembly.

<u>lvrit</u>

Year 5 carried on with the topic בְגָדִים (Bgadim – clothes). The focus of this week was on colours: פָּחוֹל (Kachol – blue), שָׁחוֹר (Chum – brown), כָּתוֹם (Katom – orange) אָפּוֹר (Afor – grey), שָׁחוֹר (Shachor – black), אָדוֹם (Adom – red), לָבָן (Yarok – green), אָדוֹם (Varod – pink), לָבָן (Lavan – white), בָּהוֹב (Tzahov – yellow) and תְּכֵלֶת (Tchelet – turquoise).
