### Dear Parents,

This week has been E Safety Week. On Tuesday, the children learnt a great deal from a workshop presented by Streetwise. This explored various essential principles for responsible use of the internet. In addition, our very own Year 4 Digital Leaders made presentations on the subject, both during the school assembly and to individual classes. The feedback from these presentations was excellent and Mrs Baron commended these children for their hard work in fulfilling their responsibilities in this role.

#### Topic / English

The children are now completing their reports on deforestation. As well as learning about the topic, this has been a valuable exercise in the important skill of organising information into distinct sections and clear paragraphs. Next week, the children will become investigative journalists and will cover a newspaper story about an incident occurring near a village in the Amazon rainforest.

### Maths

This week, the children have completed their work on column subtraction. We have also returned to the topic of time - this time, learning how to use the 24 hour clock.

## **Jewish Studies**

This week, we started our new Chumash unit where we saw how Hashem kept the promise that was made to Sara and Avraham by giving them a son, Yitzchak. By emphasising how this promise was kept, the Torah is reminding us to take all our promises seriously as well. The parasha of Terumah is all about the Mishkan that the Bnei Yisrael made while they were travelling through the wilderness. It was a very special place where they could connect with Hashem through tefillah and korbanot. We saw how each person was asked to contribute to this special place by giving sincerely what they wanted to 'in their hearts' and we discussed the importance of giving sincerely.

# <u>Ivrit</u>

Year 4 carried on with the topic food and drinks. The children are learning to name different foods and putting them into sentences. Some of the foods the children are learning to name are: תַּפּוּז (Tapuz – orange) בִּיצָה (Beitza – egg) בְּיצָה (Broccoli) פִּיצָה (Pizza) תָּה (Limon – lemon) תַּה (Te – tea) שַׁוֹקוֹלֶד (Pasta) שׁוֹקוֹלֶד (Banana) בַּנָנָה (Banana) פַּלָאפֶל (Shokolad – chocolate)

(Falafel) לָחֵם (Chalav – milk) לָחֵם (Gvina – cheese) לָחֵם (Lechem – bread) עַגְבָנָיָה (Agvania – tomato) מְלַפְפוֹן (Melafefon – cucumber).
