Science Week

For Science week, the children took part in their own Egg Drop Investigations. They planned, designed and created a safe container for an egg to be dropped from a height and were excited to see what would happen. The children were also given the chance to watch a fun experiment during the week, some watching a skittles rainbow form and others seeing a foaming monster!

<u>English</u>

In English this week, the children wrote a list of souvenirs that were on Bob's table on the moon to sell to the tourists. They also looked environmental signs and made their own sign for visitors to the moon.

<u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths, the children continued to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 while learning to group and share. The class solved multiplication and division problems before moving on to halving and doubling.

<u>Topic</u>

Jewish Studies

We made our Purim graggers from the design we created last week. We have continued to work on our Hebrew reading workbooks. We learnt in this weeks Parasha the importance of saying Thank you. We made thank you notes to give to someone special.

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This week Year 1 starting learning to say words for Purim such as: אַיָצָן (Leitzan – clown, masculine), אַיָצָרָת (Leitzanit – clown, feminine) הַאָרָים (Malka – queen), מַסָרָה (Masecha – mask), מַסָרות (Masechot – masks) and שָׁמֵחַ פּוּרִים שִׁמַחַ פּוּרִים (Purim sameach – happy Purim).

In English, the children will be designing persuasive posters and writing descriptions. In Maths, the class will be learning about fractions of shapes and amounts. In Topic, Year 1 will be looking at the different senses associated with our body parts.
