Dear Parents,

We have enjoyed a fantastic Science week in school. We enjoyed planning and carrying out our Egg Drop Challenge. It was so exciting to see how we could ensure the egg wouldn't smash! Thank you to all the parent visitors who spoke this week. Joshua's daddy spoke about the importance of charities, Eitan's mummy showed us how she made jewellery and Romy's daddy spoke to us all about his travels around the world and the airports he manages. It certainly has been fascinating finding out about different jobs.

English:

We explored leaflets in English this week. We looked at their features and saw what we thought made a great leaflet. We enjoyed looking at the slogans, bold writing and bright pictures to make them attractive to the reader. We are looking forward to writing our own leaflets next week.

Maths:

We learnt about handling data this week. We found out about tallies, pictograms and bar charts. We learnt how to answer questions and retrieve information from these charts. We also carried out time based activities linked with Science where we saw how our bodies changed during exercise.

Topic:

We learnt about how to look after our bodies in Science. We participated in a carousel of activities where we found out about how to keep healthy. We focused on: exercising and looking after our bodies, the importance of brushing our teeth, how to have a balanced diet and how important it is to sleep.

Jewish Studies

This week the children learnt about the four Mitzvot of Purim and the reasons why we do each one. We created actions and sounds to go for each one and the children enjoyed playing their own four Mitzvot of Purim game. We also sang Purim songs and rehearsed dancing routines to compliment the songs.

Ivrit

Year 2 started learning to say words for Purim such as: לֵיצָן (Leitzan – clown, masculine), לֵיצָן (Leitzanit – clown, feminine) מֵלֵכְּה (Melech – king), מֵלְכָּה (Malka – queen), מֵסֶכּוֹת (Masecha – mask), מֵסֵכּוֹת (Masechot – masks), שַׂמֵחַ פּוּרִים לְּכְבוֹד (Lichvod Purim ani... for Purim I am...) and שָׁמֵחַ פּוּרִים לְּכְבוֹד (Purim sameach – happy Purim).

The class learnt the song הַבָּה נַרְעִישָׁה (Hava narisha – let make noise) which you can find on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ccmkuh-Xx8g
