Dear Parents,

The children have had an exciting and busy week!

#### <u>English</u>

In English this week the children have continued their work with our class novel, thinking about the mysterious noise beneath the water. The children have created a story plot of what this noise could be. They planned out the language and description they would include within their writing, focusing on figurative language, including their understanding of personification and metaphors. They identified these within song lyrics and have included them in their writing.

#### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths this week the children have worked on adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator and when the denominator is a multiple of the same number. The children have been exploring changing the denominator to an equivalent fraction from a pictorial perspective before writing it symbolically. They also practised simplifying fractions through their understanding of factors.

#### **Other Areas of the Curriculum**

This week the children had an amazing time at the Barnet Dance Festival. The children worked beautifully as a class within their performance and enjoyed meeting other schools. The children this week have also been understanding the properties of yeast through a fun science experiment. They have also enjoyed different science related activities throughout science week.

#### Jewish Studies

We continued preparing for Purim by designing and constructing Mishloach Manot boxes from circles of card folded into triangles to resemble hamantashen. Children had to make their own design based on a template and work out the construction carefully. We also looked at the calendar around Purim, with Shabbat Zachor and Taanit Esther preceding the festival and Shushan Purim following it. The children practised their Purim songs and made Purim games using JI Tap.

## <u>lvrit</u>

Year 5 carried on with the topic בְּגָדִים (Bgadim – clothes). The focus of this week was on clothes in singular such as: Year 5 has started a new topic on בְּגָדִים (Bgadim – clothes). The vocabulary of this topic is: חוּלְצָה (Chultza – top), מְעָיל (Chatzayit – skirt), סָוּדָע (Kova – hat), מְעִיל (Simla – dress), מְעִיל (Meil – coat), מְעָיל (Sveder – jumper), מְעָיל (Lovesh – wearing, masculine), שִׁמְלָה, (Loveshet – wearing, feminine), and we combined clothes with colours: אָפור (Kachol – blue), חוּם (Chum – brown), פָּתום (Katom – orange) אָפור (Afor – grey), קוו (Shachor – black), אָפור (Adom – red), יָרוק (Yarok – green), אָכָל (Lavan – white), בנות (Tzahov – yellow) and תְּכָלֶת (Tchelet – turquoise). The class started learning the song כָּר แלד הצבע (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=VT1R37o-d3I.

#### Ideas for things you could do at home:

- Please continue to read with your child and ask them questions to develop their comprehension skills.
- Practise spelling the Year 4 and 5 Common Exception Words and using them within sentences.
- Mathletics and TT Rockstars are both great ways to improve and practice number fluency and reinforce our learning from class.


