Dear Parents,

The children have been learning more about Temples, Tombs and Treasures.

English

In English, the children continued to look at the book Egyptian Cinderella. They began the week by comparing Egyptian Cinderella to traditional Cinderella and looking at the similarities and differences between the two. They then looked at the patterns of traditional well-known stories and how they are set out. They will use this to retell the story of Egyptian Cinderella.

Maths

In Maths, the children continued to learn about fractions. They identified different fractions, their value and recognised how many make a whole. They also learnt about tenths and how tenths arise from dividing an object into 10.

Jewish studies

This week in Jewish Studies we spent time discussing in our Chumash lessons the promise given to Avram that Eretz Yisrael will belong to Avram's descendants. We also explored Avrams travels around Canaan and how he brought understanding of Hashem to those places.

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 carried on with the topic: הַמִּשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלִּי – My family. The class will continue learning this topic throughout this term. The words for this topic include: מִשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלָּי (Mishpacha – family), סַבָּא (Saba – grandfather), סְבְּתָא (Savta – grandmother), אָח קָטָן (Ima – mum), אַבָּא (Aba – dad), אָח גָדוֹל (Ach gadol – big brother), אָח קָטָן (Ach katan – little brother), אָח מָי זֶהי (Achot gdola – big sister), אָחוֹת גְדוֹלָה (Achot ktana – little sister), מִי זֶהי (Mi ze? – who is it? Masculine), מֵי זֹאֹת (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), מֵי זֹאֹת (Yesh li – I do have), דוֹדָה (Doda – aunt), דוֹד (Doda – aunt), בַּת דוֹדָה (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), בַּת דוֹדָה (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).

Other areas of the curriculum

The children learnt about the different Pharaohs of Egypt. They learnt about the importance of these Pharaohs and thought about whether they thought they were good rulers. They compared this to the knowledge about tombs and treasures.
