Dear Parents,

We have had another great week of learning in Year 2! We would like to thank Mrs Sapir for visiting us and telling us all about her job as an interior designer. We loved hearing all about the interesting work she does.

English:

We read the story of Cinderella this week as part of our topic of fairy tales. We retold the story and sequenced it using traditional fairy tale language. We spent time finding out about the different characters in the story and we explored different ways to describe them. We tried hard to make imaginative language choices and refer back to the text to support our ideas.

Maths:

We have found fractions of shapes this week as well as finding fractions of amounts. We know how to find halves and quarters in a variety of ways.

Topic:

The children finished creating their plates of healthy food. They considered what food is healthy and used this knowledge to create a collage plate of healthy food.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies, we have started learning about Pesach. We learned about the different parts of the Seder plate and began to learn about the Pesach story. Additionally, we started learning about the different parts of the Seder order and began to create our very own Haggadah.

Ivrit

Year 2 started to learn to say שָׁמֵחַ פַּסְח (Pesach sameach – happy Pesach) שָׂמֵחַ חַגּ (Chag sameach – happy festival) שָׁמֵחַ חַגּ (Tzalachat – plate), פָּרְפָּר (Beitza – egg), מָצָה (Matza) אָנִיחָת (Egoz – nut), פָּרְפָּר (Parpar- butterfly), חָבָּי (Perach – flower) and אָפִיקוֹמָן (Afikoman). The class began learning the song (Be'egozim nesacheka – we will play with nuts) which you can find on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=peLcC_amjm4
