Dear Parents,

The children have continued incorporating Temples, Tombs and Treasures in their learning.

## **English**

In English, the children looked at retelling the story of Egyptian Cinderella. They looked at the pattern of well-known fairy tale stories and planned their retelling with this same pattern. They came up very with creative ideas about her trip to the ball. They also explored past tense verbs to help them when retelling their story.

### **Maths**

In Maths, the children continued to learn about fractions. They recognised that tenths was splitting an object into ten equal pieces and explored how many tenths were in red and blue of different rectangles. They also learnt equivalent fractions and used the fraction wall to find fractions that were equivalent to a half.

#### **Jewish studies**

This week in Jewish Studies, we have started our Pesach learning. We discussed the Pesach story using a variety of props. We reviewed the parts of the Seder and discussed what we do in each part and the reasons. Additionally, we started making our class Hagaddah. We went into pairs and started creating pages for the Hagaddah using JI Studio on the IPads.

# <u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 carried on with the topic: הַמִּשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלִּי – My family. The class will continue learning this topic throughout this term. The words for this topic include: מִשְׁפָּחָה (Mishpacha – family), סַבָּא (Saba – grandfather), סָבְּתָא (Savta – grandmother), אָח קָטָן (Ima – mum), אַבָּא (Aba – dad), אָח גְּדוֹל (Ach gadol – big brother), אָח קָטָן (Ach katan – little brother), אָח קָטָן (Achot gdola – big sister), אָחוֹת גְדוֹלָה (Achot ktana – little sister), מִי זֶה? (Mi ze? – who is it? Masculine), מִי זאֹת? (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), שִׁין לִי (Ein li – I don't have), שַׁ לִי (Pesh li – I do have), דוֹדָ ה (Dod – aunt), דוֹדָה (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), בּת דוֹדָה (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).

# Other areas of the curriculum

The children learnt about the process of mummification and what happened when an Egyptian Pharaoh was mummified. They looked at different cards of the process and ordered them. The children related their learning about taking out organs during mummification to learning about the digestive system and the function and purpose of some of the main organs. The children labelled digestive systems.
