Dear Parents,

Another busy week for Year 4 as we progress through the term's work.

<u>Maths</u>

This week, we have been finishing our work on multiplication. The children have been using multiplication and division facts to find solutions to a range of word problems. We also introduced the idea of 'cross number' puzzles – the same as cross word puzzles but using numbers instead of letters! The children first tried to complete a cross number puzzle and then created their own puzzle using multiplication and division facts as the clues.

Topic / English

Last week, the children were learning about the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun. This week, the children have been imagining that they were present at this great find and writing an eye witness account. Their first task was to plan the account, thinking carefully about the content, structure and other success criteria. They then embarked on writing their account. Next week, this eye witness account will act as a starting point for writing a newspaper report about the discovery.

Jewish Studies

In Jewish Studies, we focused on preparing for Pesach. We practised all the songs that we will be singing at the Seder and we discussed all the parts of the Seder to remind ourselves of the story and the different actions we do. The children then started planning and creating their own pages of the Haggadah, which include both an explanation of the part as well as an activity related to the part. We will be putting all the pages together so that children can take home copies of their own Haggadot to use on Pesach.

<u>lvrit</u>

Year 4 carried on with the topic food and drinks. The children are learning to name different foods and putting them into sentences. Some of the foods the children are learning to name are: תַּפּוּז (Tapuz – orange) בַּיצָה (Beitza – egg) בְּרוֹקוֹלִי (Broccoli) בִּיצָה (Pizza) (Limon – lemon) תַּה (Te – tea) תַּה (Pasta) (Pasta) שׁוֹקוֹלָד (Banana) שׁוֹקוֹלָד (Shokolad – chocolate) פָּלָאפֶל (Falafel) מָלָבּנָנָה (Chalav – milk) מָלֶבְּפִוֹן (Gvina – cheese) עַגְּבָנָיָה (Lechem – bread) מָגְבָנָיָה (Melafefon – cucumber).
