

Dear Parents,

This week the children have continued learning about Pesach with a big range of activities. They learnt about how Hashem spoke with Moshe and asked him to free the Jewish people with his help. We watched a clip of “The Prince of Egypt” so they could learn about the 10 plagues. Their favourite activity of the week was to accurately create puppets that represented these plagues.

They also had time to bake matzah from scratch, as part of the SEED workshop. They enjoyed tasting it and feeling the crunchiness. They also enjoyed learning a big selection of Pesach songs, some of them in Ivrit like “Daveinu” and some in English like “I love Matzah”.

During the Jewish Studies lesson Nursery learnt all about the Seder night. They learnt everything that has to be eaten during that night and also the reason behind it. They enjoyed making their own Charoset and also eating parsley, egg and lettuce dipped in salty water. There was time to create some crafts that you will see next week.

This week Nursery carried on to learn to say פֶּסַח שְׂמֵיחַ (Pesach sameach – happy Pesach) and חַג שְׂמֵיחַ (Chag sameach – happy festival). The class started learning the song שִׂמְחָה רַבָּה (Simcha raba – lots of happiness) which you can find on <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=MTm0uTGIMbY>
