## Dear Parents,

#### <u>English</u>

In English this week, the children reread the story 'A Day in the Life' by Simon Bartram and began to plan a sequel to the story, this time based on the day of one of the aliens, or a day of one the tourists. Children thought about their main characters and the different exciting events that might happen in their story.

## <u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths, the children began learning how to tell the time, using their knowledge of halves and quarters to help them. They made their own clock face then looked at different times on clocks and put these in order.

Continuous Provision The children have worked on the following activities to enhance their learning this week: Phonics Fun: reading words at speed Magical Maths: finding halves and quarters of different amounts Funky Physical: following the footprints to escape from Egypt Creation Station: 10 plagues pinwheel Writing Area: comparing the modern author JK Rowling to Charles Dickens from 150 years ago Computer Zone: Using http://www.abcya.com/typing\_rocket\_junior.htm to practise typing the letters Jewish Studies: Designing a cup for Elijah for our seder.

### <u>Science</u>

The class investigated the properties of various materials this week, looking at pictures of pieces of equipment that people might use in their jobs and thinking of words to describe the item and the material it is made from. The children discussed why a wall is made from brick and not paper, why a window is made from glass and not rubber and why a builder's hat is made from hard plastic and not fabric.

### Jewish Studies

We are still working on our Haggadot. The children are learning so much, we are working our way through each stage of the seder, answering questions in our own way and we look forward to sharing with you our beautiful Haggadah on seder night. We also baked matza at the matzah baking workshop which was a wonderful hands on matza baking treat.

### lvrit

This week Year 1 carried on to learn to say שְׁמֵחַ פֵּסַח (Pesach sameach – happy Pesach) שָׁמֵחַ חַג (Chag sameach – happy festival) שָׁמֵחַ (Tzalachat – plate), בֵּיָצָה (Beitza – egg), מָצָה (Matza) and זָאָגוֹזים (Egoz – nut).
