Dear Parents,

We have had another great week of learning in Year 2! We would like to thank Mrs Daly for visiting us and teaching us all about the importance of looking after our teeth and keeping them healthy. Thank you so much for our fabulous tooth brushes!

English:

We compared different traditional tales this week and looked out for similarities and differences. We also explored different fairy tales and their settings. We looked at different settings in more detail and used oil pastels to create a fairy tale setting. We then brainstormed imaginative words and phrases to describe our settings. We look forward to using our ideas to write our own fairy tale stories next week.

Maths:

We explored equivalent fractions and found fractions of amounts this week. We learnt that fractions are equal parts of a whole. We cut up strips to demonstrate what fractions are the same as each other. Eg. We found out that $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{4}$. We also compared fractions where we used < and > signs to compare $\frac{3}{8}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ - which one is larger?

Topic:

The children designed a special Pesach craft to share with you on Seder night. They worked hard to make it really special to take home.

Jewish Studies

Year Two had a very busy week writing and illustrating their Haggadot and practising songs and parts for their Pesach Seder on Monday.

Ivrit

Year 2 carried on to learn to say שָׁמֵחַ פֵּסַח (Pesach sameach – happy Pesach) שָׂמֵחַ חַג (Chag sameach – happy festival) שָׁמֵחַ חַג (Tzalachat – plate), מָצָה (Beitza – egg), מָצָה (Matza) אַכּוֹז (Egoz – nut), פָּרְפָּר (Parpar- butterfly), חָבָי (Perach – flower) and אָפִיקוֹמְן (Afikoman). The class began learning the song נְּשָׁחֵקָה בָּאֶגוֹזִים (Be'egozim nesacheka – we will play with nuts) which you can find on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=peLcC_amjm
