Dear Parents,

The highlight of this week for Year 4 was the trip to the British Museum to the see the exhibition on Ancient Egypt. We spent our afternoon exploring the amazing discoveries from the time and learning about life in Egypt. There was a particular focus on seeing the mummies and understanding more about the practice of mummification. Ms Pieters led a fascinating tour around the exhibition and made many links with the story of Pesach. The trip has also helped the children to identify ideas for their contribution to a collage that we are creating focusing on life by the River Nile.

## **Maths**

This week, the children have been completing a range of challenges to practise counting in various multiples and trying to solve a series of related word problems. Do please keep supporting the children in learning their times tables. It is so important that they achieve fluency in terms of accuracy and speed.

### **Topic / English**

The children have embarked on writing a newspaper report on the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun. We have been discussing the key components of a newspaper report and thinking about the success criteria depending on the target audience. We will be drawing out the distinctions between the different styles of writing in different types of newspaper. They have used their eye witness accounts as a starting point for the report and they will include quotations from their eye witness account in the report.

## **Science**

The children have been learning about the different types of teeth and their functions. They also carried out and wrote up an experiment to see the effect of different types of liquid on teeth.

#### **Jewish Studies**

We have been in Pesach mode all week, working hard to prepare our class Haggadot for Pesach, with children creating information and quizzes about the various parts of the Haggadah to share at home. We have also been practising songs for the Seder and getting ready for Pesach in various other ways, including our amazing trip to the British Museum to study real objects from Egypt, bringing the Pesach story to life. The children also enjoyed a matzo baking workshop led by Tzivos Hashem.

#### **Ivrit**

Year 4 carried on with the topic food and drinks. The children are learning to name different foods and putting them into sentences. Some of the foods the children are learning to name are: תַּפּוּז (Tapuz – orange) בַּינְיָה (Beitza – egg) בְּרוֹקוֹלִי (Broccoli) בִּינְה (Pizza) בִּינְה (Limon – lemon) תַּה (Te – tea) תַּה (Pasta) (Humous) תַּלָב (Banana) שַּׁלְּכֶד (Shokolad – chocolate) בְּלָאפֶל (Falafel) תַּלְבּנְיָה (Chalav – milk) בְּבִינָה (Gvina – cheese) בְּלָהָפ (Lechem – bread) עַּגְּבָנִיָּה (Melafefon – cucumber).
