The children have had an exciting and busy week in preparation for Pesach.

<u>English</u>

In English this week the children have continued their work with our class book: A Boy and a Bear in a Boat. We have continued reading our story and have discovered an abandoned ship in the middle of the ocean. The children have developed their inference skills further by creating scripts about the moments before the ship was abandoned. They applied their understanding of colons and brackets into this context and performed them to the class. The children have also been looking at the key features of a fairy tale. They have been text marking a story to identify the key features.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we have completed our work with fractions and have moved on to decimals. The children have consolidated their learning from last year on hundredths and tenths. They found tenths and hundredths between given numbers, and have written these numbers in words. The children were also introduced to thousandths this week. As a class, they created large numbers using baseboards and numicon and then applied these skills to pictorial representations on thousandths. The children also learnt how to write numbers containing thousandths and the correct way to say them.

Other Areas of the Curriculum

This week the children had the opportunity to practise their cooking skills with Reception using a combination of different ingredients and their journey from liquid to solids they were able to explain the change of state of the particles. The children reviewed the reversible and irreversible changes of cooking. This week they also completed their Pesach cushions and are excited to share them with you over Pesach.

Jewish Studies

We have been in Pesach mode all week, working hard to prepare our class Haggadot for Pesach, with children creating information and quizzes about the various parts of the Haggadah to share at home. We have also been practising songs for the seder and getting ready for Pesach in various other ways. The children also enjoyed making Matzvah this week!

<u>lvrit:</u>

Year 5 carried on with the topic בְּגָדִים (Bgadim – clothes). The focus of this week was on clothes in singular such as: Year 5 has started a new topic on בְּגָדִים (Bgadim – clothes).
