We have had another great week of learning in Year 2! We kick started the week with our fantastic Seder! Thank you all for coming, for joining in and helping to make it a really special and memorable event for the children.

English:

We were excited to plan our very own fairy tales. We loved thinking about different characters and settings that we could use for our story. We can't wait to finish writing them and share them with the class.

Maths:

We practised solving problems this week. We remembered our learning of the 4 operations and used this to solve word problems. Examples included:

My plant was 12cm tall. It grew 9cm more, how tall is it now?

_____ - _____ = 2 (but each of these numbers have to be larger than 20)

I have 20p with only 2p coins. How many 2p coins do I have?

Topic:

The finished working on their powerpoints about what they want to be when they grow up. We have really enjoyed seeing how creative they have been. They have loved inserting pictures and adding special effects.

Jewish Studies

Year 2 had a great week starting off with the school Seder and finishing the week with putting the finishing touches on their Haggadot and making up Gematria sums to do with Pesach.

Ivrit

This term Year 2's main focus was Shabbat and the chagim: Chag Tu B'shvat, Chag Purim and chag Pesach. The children used related vocabulary, names of objects, food, greetings and phrases, combined together with previous knowledge: pronouns, verbs, and family members to create longer sentences in Ivrit. They also learnt songs related to Shabbat and each chag.
