Dear Parents,

In the countdown to Pesach, the highlight of this week for Year 4 was the model Seder. Parents and Grandparents joined the children and staff to enjoy the Seder experience. The children all participated and sang the songs enthusiastically. There was a lovely atmosphere and the model Seder was much enjoyed by all attending.

<u>Maths</u>

It has been a busy half term in Maths, but there has been just enough time to cover one last topic before the end of term holiday. The class have been looking at methods for presenting discrete and continuous data, in particular bar charts and time charts. It has been a valuable exercise requiring not only an understanding of the relevant graphic format, but also accuracy drawing and labelling the axes and precision in presenting the data.

Topic / English

The children have been completing their newspaper reports on the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun. The children have learnt about the structure and content of newspaper reports and this activity has been an enjoyable way to conclude the study of our topic Tombs, Temples and Treasures.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies we continued working on our Haggadot - explaining parts of the Seder and creating fun games for the Seder table. We also practised our songs for the Seder and then had the opportunity to lead the Seder with our parents - a very special experience. We worked on our crafts of mummies in a sarcophagus - we are planning to bring these to the Seder table so that we can talk about how Yaakov and Yosef were mummified and how Hashem hardened Paro's heart, which to an Egyptian was a clear sign that he would not get access to the afterlife.

Year 4 carried on with the topic food and drinks. The children are learning to name different foods and putting them into sentences.
