<u>English</u>

In English, the children created their own information posters to encourage the school to 'Save the World', helping to coin the phrase 'The World Needs Saving, So Start Behaving'. They were excited to place the posters around the school. The children then made their own information zig-zag books, reiterating why we need to be kinder to our world.

<u>Maths</u>

This week the children continued with place value, using base ten blocks (visibly showing ones, tens and hundreds) to make various 2- and 3-digit numbers. We watched the video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=a4FXl4zb3E4 a number of times, with the children singing along to the chorus. The children then used their knowledge of place value to add and subtract two digit numbers.

<u>Topic</u>

The children completed a round robin of various Science-based activities linked with plants and trees. They watched a video showing an apple tree's changes
