Dear Parents,

The children have had an exciting and busy week discovering the different elements to our new topic: Extreme Survivors. This week our focus has been on the Cave animals.

English

In English this week the children have been focusing description. The children have been writing a narrative about the moment a brown bear awakes form hibernation. The children created a mindmap focusing on sounds and what you can see from a forest environment. They took their observations and created beautiful examples of personification with in. the children then story-boxed their plan and creating a language plan which contained a range of grammatical features looked at in class. The children then wrote their narrative and upleveling in either pairs or independently.

Maths

This week in Maths, the children have been completing Maths questions based on their understanding of decimals. The children have been focusing on applying their understanding of decimals to problem solving contexts to ensure they understand and consolidate their learning of decimals.

Other Areas of the Curriculum

In science this week the children have been focusing on cave environments. The children created mindmaps on researching cave animals and how they are adapted for these conditions. The children also learnt about why animals hibernate and why they chose caves as their location for this.

Jewish Studies

This has been a very short week for Jewish Studies but we still managed to learn quite a bit about Lag BaOmer and linking it to our learning of Jewish history. We looked at what the omer was in Biblical times and how Lag baOmer happened in Rabbinic times, in particular at the time when Rabbi Akiva and Rabbi Shimon Bar Yochai lived. The children all received personal invitations to the Etgar quiz and we are working hard to prepare for an amazing day packed with a variety of quiz activities.

Ivrit:

Year 5 have started this week their end of topic assessment task about clothes - בָּגִדִּים (Bgadim). They are assessed on all the words they learnt throughout this topic and how they are creating sentences with them. The words that the assessment is about are: הַּלְצָה (Chultza – top), הַצָּאִית (Chatzayit – skirt), הַנְּעָהִים (Kova – hat), מְנְכַּיִים (Simla – dress), מְנִידֶּר (Meil – coat), מְנְיַדָּר (Sveder – jumper), מְנְכַיִים (Magafayim – boots), מְנְיַדְיֹם (Sandalim – sandals), מְנִילִים (Meilim – coats), שְׂמָלוֹת (Chultzot – tops), שְׁמָלוֹת (Lovesh – dresses), הַּנְצִיוֹת (Hatzaiot – skirts), בּנְבִייִם (Kovaim – hats), הוֹלְצֵיוֹת (Chultzot – tops), בְּהוֹל (Lovesh – wearing, masculine), הוֹב (Loveshet – wearing, feminine), and we combined clothes with colours: בְּהוֹל (Kachol – blue), שְׁהוֹר (Chum – brown), בָּתוֹם (Sagol – purple), יְרוֹד (Varod – pink), בְּלָת בּלָת הערבר (Tzahov – yellow) and אַדוֹב (Tchelet – turquoise).
