We have had another great week in Year 2. We loved starting the week by watching the Year 6 play – it was so great to see what a fantastic show they put on! On Wednesday we loved making chocolate krispie cakes to sell at the Jewish Care bake sale. They tasted delicious!

English:

We began publishing our holiday brochures this week. We thought about the layout as well as the audience and purpose for our brochure. We worked so hard to make it look attractive and appealing to anyone who was interested!

Maths:

This week we learnt division as sharing and revised our understanding of the concept. We used our knowledge of times tables to solve simple calculations involving division. We explore the inverse relationship between multiplication and division and learnt how to use the inverse when checking our work.

Science:

We completed our bean investigation! We compared all of our beans and discussed which ones grew the best. We were surprised that the beans on the window sill didn't grow as well as those with cling film on. It was so exciting to see if our bean had grown. This week's **home learning** will be to plant a bean and watch it grow. The children will need to use what they learnt in order to decide what the best conditions would be to grow a bean. Jewish Studies

We have been learning the last few script Hebrew letters in the Aleph Bet. Very soon the children will be receiving their personal script certificates as an achievement award for knowing how to proficiently read and write all the Hebrew script letters.

Ivrit

Year 2 are reading the book **ישראל בארץ** Be'Eretz Israel (In the land of Israel). They will carry on reading the story for the next few weeks. In the book the children are exploring different areas in Israel and different contexts within Israel such as cities, transport, plants and people.
