This has been a really busy week for Nursery. We continued learning about Sand and Water and it has been amazing to see the children's creativity. Their big source of interest and learning this week has been castles. They have been making them out of wet sand, playdough and salt dough and they have also been drawing them, showing a great deal of detail.

Each child has shown us their different perceptions of castles and it has been fascinating to see how well they can focus and create more complex pictures. Their roleplay has been also around the castle theme and their favourite character and story Rapunzel. They have been telling the story with puppets and it has been wonderful to see them working as a team to bring the story to life.

During the Jewish studies lessons, the children have continued learning about kosher animals, this time around birds. They have been really interested in finding out more and have asked many questions.
