

Dear Parents

Wow, we are impressed and we are sure you will be too on Tuesday! The children have been working so hard on their Aleph Bet play, and have loved practising. They were fantastic in their dress rehearsal on Tuesday in front of the school. They know all their words and songs and have tried so hard. Thank you so much to you all for your help. We look forward to welcoming you to our show on Tuesday and we are sure you will be as proud of your children as we are.

The children have been super busy getting ready to move up to Year One! They had their second transition activity on Wednesday afternoon, where they listened to a story and talked to their buddies about any worries they have about Year One. If their buddies were unable to help them they asked the teachers as well.

To help the Nursery children get ready for Reception, each child has written a letter to the Nursery children and the new children who will be joining Reception in September, about all the lovely things and great learning that we do in Reception. They started their letter with 'Dear ...' and chose a child's name from a list.

We have been looking at time and days of the week this week. The children have been writing about what they do on different days and have been looking at the time on clocks. We also talked about the different things we do at different times of the day. The children created their own daily plan with lovely pictures and writing.

This week Reception carried on learning to say ילדות (yeladot) – girls, ילדים (yeladim) – boys, זבֵּרוֹת (zebrot) – zebras, דולפינים (dolfinim) – dolphins, אִמָּא (Ima) – mum/ mother, אָבֵא (Aba) – dad/father, לֹא (Lo) – No, כֵּן (Ken) – Yes, אוֹ (Oh) – or, וְ...
