This week we have we have been very busy and have gone off timetable.

School Trips and Visitors:

This week we concluded our work with Rabbi Bazak and the children got to ask their final questions about Kashrut, laws and another other queries.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this week the children have begun their work on understanding a range of different measurements. This week we have begun our work with the metric system and we have investigated went to use each measurement and the relationship between them. Next week we will begin comparing this to the imperial system.

<u>English</u>

We have also begun to work on the school newspaper I have begun compiling information about the different opportunities and visitors we have had this year. The children have also been given the responsibility of creating a range of different puzzle pages for the newspaper. Each of these pages relate to a different aspect of Etz Chaim.

<u>Science</u>

In science this week we have been looking at animal food chains. The children have been identifying herbivores carnivores and omnivores and not able to distinguish between the three. The children have also been looking at the terminology: Prey, predator, consumer and producer. They have use this terminology to create detailed food chains of what could happen in the Savannah, and the impact a food chain has on the environment.

Lastly throughout the week the children have been reflecting on the school year. They have been compiling their favourite memories of the year and use this information in our End of Term Assembly. We hope you enjoyed it.

Year 5 carried on their end of topic assessment task about clothes - בְּגָדִים (Bgadim).
