Dear Parents,

The children have had a great and busy week preparing for Succot.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this week the children have been focusing on understanding a number line. The children have been counting in tens to complete a number line to 50 and 100. The children have been placing numbers in the correct places based on their understanding on ordering numbers to 100.

English

In English this week the children have been working very hard on hot seating our main character. They have written a range of questions they would like to ask Camilla if they could. The children worked very hard to ensure that they included the correct punctuation at the beginning and end of their sentences. This week we have also focused on handwriting. The children have been working on letter formation using a whiteboard and pen as well as their hands. We were very fortunate to have a Drama session where the children learnt about the roles in a fairy tale and how to trick a dragon. The children loved getting involved and working as a team.

Other areas of the curriculum

This week the children began their Da Capo lessons where they are learning how to read music, sing the correct notes and different melodies. In Science the children have been learning how to label different parts of the body. They were able to label these parts independently. For Mental Health Awareness Week the children coloured in mindfulness colouring patterns after a long discussion about what it means to exercise our brains and relax.

Jewish Studies

The children learnt about the rules of a kosher sukkah and built their own kosher sukkot using Lego and straws. We also started learning about the lulav and etrog and demonstrated to the children how we shake them and which brachot to make.

<u>lvrit</u>

Year 2 learnt to say the names of the seven species – המינים שבעת (shivat haminim) of Israel: חיטה (chita) wheat, אעורה (seora) barley, גפן (gefen) grapes, תאנה (te'ena) fig, רימון (rimon) pomegranate, זית (za'it) olive, רימון (tamar) date.

The class started learning the song 'Eretz chita'.
