Dear Parents,

The children have had a great and busy week this Succot. They really enjoyed visiting the Mill Hill Shul Succah. The children shook the lulav and etrog, played games and sang lovely Succot songs. Thank you so much for the parents who volunteered to help us with the trip.

Maths

In Maths this week the children have been consolidating their understanding of numbers as words. They matched the word to the number and practised writing the numbers independently. The children have also been using chocolate to review place value knowledge in numbers up to hundreds.

English

In English this week the children have been reviewing expanded noun phrases. They created sentences and up-levelled them to include expanded noun phrases. We have also concluded our story on Camilla Stripes and the children learnt the importance of being true to who you are and not being afraid to be different.

Other areas of the curriculum

In Science/Topic this week the children began their work on Black History Month. To help the children understand the impact of Mary Secole, we have explored what medicine is like today. We explored how medical and non-medical treatments help us when we are ill. The children have also been working on their observation drawing skills. The children drew the lulav and Etrog from observation which we then reduced and the children coloured it in using different media.

Jewish Studies

Apart from the visit to Mill Hill Shul sukkah, the children participated in a variety of Succot activities and linked their class learning to Succot in a variety of ways.

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 2 learnt to say the names of the seven species – חיטה (shivat haminim) of Israel: חיטה (shivat haminim) of Israel: תאנה (te'ena) tig, שעורה, (rimon) (te'ena) tig, רימון (rimon) אפן (tamar) date.

The class started learning the song 'Eretz chita'.
