Dear Parents,

Year 3 have had a great week of Sukkot filled learning. The children got a chance to go into the school sukkah and visit the sukkah at Mill Hill shul.

Maths

This week, it was Chocolate Maths Week. The children continued to look at weight and mass and related it to chocolate. They estimated how much they thought different chocolate bars weighed. They ordered these chocolates from heaviest to lightest. The children then weighed the chocolate to see how close their estimations were. As an extra challenge, the children added and subtracted different chocolate weights.

English

In English, the children wrote a book review about the story of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. They explored what a book review was by looking at a variety of different books and examples. They wrote what the book was about, their favourite part of the book and who they might recommend the book to.

Other areas of the curriculum

The children began to familiarise themselves with Black History Month, as they will be completing work on this after half term. They also continued to order the history of chocolate on a timeline.

Jewish Studies

This week we have all been into the school sukkah to experience shaking the lulav and etrog and enjoy some pastries. We practised saying the brachot for eating in a sukkah and the children were proud to see the decorations they had made for the sukkah. The highlight of the week was our visit to the sukkah at Mill Hill Shul and performing exciting skits about the Ushpizin with Year 6!

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 learnt the words: סוכה (succa), קיר (kir) wall, סכך (schach), פטיש (patish) hammer, מסמר (masmer) nail, שמח סוכות חג (boneh) build, and the phrase שמח סוכות חג (Chag Succot Same'ach) Happy festival of Succot.

The class started learning the song מְּסֶמֶר פַּטִישׁ (Patish Masmer – hammer nail) which you can find on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o7D5sSpfk_4
