The children sang Succot songs that Mrs Meyer and Mrs Talisman had taught them. Last week the children decorated a large box to look like a Succah. This week they went in their role-play Succah, pretended to go to sleep and fed all the babies.

The children were very grown up, and asked Miss Genn if they could choose an activity to go on the table. They chose to make Lulav's and Etrogs out of collage materials. The children worked together to get the right coloured tissue paper and crayons, as well as glue and spreaders. They then made lovely Succot pictures.

The children made lemony playdough, as they said it smelt like Etrogs. The then used scissors to cut the playdough. The children will be practising their cutting skills throughout the year.
