Dear Parents,

Year 3 have had a busy week getting back into their learning and involving themselves in their new topic.

Maths

In Maths, the children started looking at addition and subtraction. The looked at addition and subtraction with multiples of 100. They discussed what a multiple was and began problem solving and reasoning with calculations involving multiples of 100. The children also used resources such a place value charts to solve 1 digit numbers added and subtracted to three digit numbers. Again, children applied this knowledge to different problem solving investigations where they had to justify whether certain facts were true or false.

English

In English, the children were introduced to their new book 'Belonging'. They had a look at the front cover and made predictions on what they thought the story was going to be about and their reasons. They also recapped simple, complex and compound sentences and wrote some about the front cover of the book. They are very excited to start reading their new book!

Other areas of the curriculum

The children immersed themselves in their new topic Generation Game. They thought about what the topic might be about and they thought about what the word Generation might mean. They were given pictures of children at different stages in the life cycle. In groups, they were told to order these pictures and identify what stages of life they were in. They discussed the physical similarities and differences between the pictures.

Year 3 carried on with our new topic of 'Who am וֹ?' מֵי אַנִי

The children also use an app called Touch of Hebrew, which you can download onto ipads at home for free.

The key words on our topic include: מָי (Mi – who), אֲתָה (Ani – I am), אַתָּה (Ata – you are), אַרְט (Ata – you are), שַלוֹם (Boker tov – good morning), לַיְלָה טוֹב (Lila tov – good night), שָלוֹם (Shalom – hello), שָלוֹם (Lehitraot – good bye), מִי אַתָּה! (Mi ata? – who are you?), יְאַרָּ אוֹת (Mi at? – who are you?), אֵיךְ קוֹרְאִים לְךָּוּ (Eich korim lecha? – what is your name? masculine), אֵיךְ קוֹרְאִים לְךָּוּ (Eich korim lach? – what is your name? feminine), מָה שְׁלוֹמֶדְי (Ma shlomcha? – how are you? Masculine), מָה שְלוֹמֵדְי (Ma shlomech? – how are you? Feminine), מְצוּיָרָ (Ma nishma? – how are you?), אֶפְשֶׁר גַם! (Efshar gam? – may I also have?).

The class is learning the song אֶלוֹהִים שֶׁלִי (Elohim sheli – my God) which you can find here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=534t0Ny5iIA
