#### English

In English, the children revised writing simple sentences, understanding that they must have capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and make sense. They made decorations for the celebrations they had planned before moving on to rewriting some well-known celebratory songs.

# Maths

This week, the class continued using their knowledge of 2s, 5s and 10s by estimating how many cubes were in a stack, before counting the cubes in groups. The children then counted groups of marbles, beads and wooden discs in 2s, 5s and 10s to find the whole amount. They were then introduced to the concept of sharing by 2s, 5s and 10s, the start of learning division.

## **Jewish Studies**

This week we continued to extend our Hebrew reading by playing Hebrew flashcard games and using the Ipads for fun reading activities. In the Parashah we explained that Hashem tells Avram that all the land which he can see will be for him and his children after him. He also tells him that his children will be as many as the dust of the earth and the stars in the sky. We are the children of Avram. Just as Avram listened to Hashem so too must we also try to follow in his good ways.

Year 1 carried on learning the topic of the days of the week.
