The children have been very excited to learn about Diwali and Bonfire Night. They used the Interactive Whiteboard to make pictures of fireworks and designed their own henna hands. The children also used toothbrushes and straws to make fireworks paintings with glitter.

The children have loved learning about jungle animals this week. We set up a jungle, under the sea and arctic area on some shelves and the children have been sorting the animals in to the right habitats. We read 'Dear Zoo', and the children drew the different animals in the story on the Interactive Whiteboard.
