In English, the children watched

We spent no pens day reading and performing the Julia Donaldson story 'Sharing a Shell', to help the children with Friendship Week. They then began looking at the book 'Orion and the Dark' by Emma Yarlett by discussing the picture of the boy and what they think he might be feeling.

Maths

This week, the class were introduced to the topic of height and length. They began by measuring using non-standard units and cubes to work out how long or tall different objects were. For no pens day, the children went on a shape

Topic: Let's Celebrate

The children commemorated Remembrance Day by labelling a picture of a soldier and the materials that his clothing is made from. They were able to notice that the hard, plastic chair they sit on felt different to the soft, cushioned chair that the teacher sits on.

Jewish Studies

This week the children learned to blend the Kamatz vowel with a combination of letters.

In the Parashah we explained that Avraham arrives in Eretz Cana'an. He welcomes three visitors to his tent. He brings them water to wash their feet and tells them to rest under the tree. Then he hurries to organise and prepare a delicious meal for them. We learn from Avraham's actions how to welcome and care for guests.

Ivrit

The class is learning the song היום יום איזה? (Eize yom Hayom – what day is it today).

Next Week

In English, the children will be discovering Orion's fears and listing some of their own.

In Maths, the class will be continuing to measure length and height.

In Topic, Year 1 will be looking at road safety.

In JS, Year 1 we will learn how we blend the Kamatz in a closed two lettered word.
