Dear Parents,

This week the children have been getting involved in lots of topic based learning.

Maths

In Maths, the children began the week recapping the column method and practising this with two and three digit numbers. They also subtracted pairs of numbers using partitioning into hundreds, tens and ones. They applied this so a variety of questions where they had to reason and problem solve.

English

In English, the children wrote poems based on a picture from the class book Belonging. They looked carefully at the photograph and wrote rhyming couplets based on what they could see. They responded to the poem and discussed what they liked about each other's poems.

Other areas of the curriculum

The children looked at different artists who had represented elderly people. They thought about what features the artist had used to represented an elderly person. We discussed this as a class and they used their sketch books to recreate a representation half of their face in 60 years.

The children also looked at where different members of their family were from. They used atlases and other maps to plot the countries and describe the locations.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies the children have been learning how to find the place in the Chumash. They also learnt about the fight between Yaakov and Esav over the birth-right and how his parents helped them in the situation they were in.

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 carried on learning the topic שֶׁלִי הַמִּשְׁפָּחָה — My family. The class will be learning this topic throughout this half term. The words for this topic include:

קּפְּחָה (Mishpacha – family), אָמָא (Ima – grandfather), סָבָת, (Savta – grandmother), אָמָא (Ima – mum), אָבָא (Aba – dad), גָדוֹל אָח (Ach gadol – big brother), קָטָן אָח (Ach katan – little brother), אָחוֹת (Achot gdola – big sister), זְה מִי (Achot ktana – little sister), זָה מִי (Mi ze? – who is it? Masculine), יָזאֹת מִי (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), יָזאֹת מֵי (Ein li – I don't

have), לִי יֵשׁ (Yesh li – I do have), דוֹד (Dod – uncle), דוֹד (Doda – aunt), דוֹד בָּן (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), דוֹד בָּת (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).
