Dear Parents,

Here's a short overview of another great week in Year 4:

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this week, the children have been exploring a range of geometric shapes and identifying the properties in each case. This has involved careful comparison and measurement to distinguish between one shape and another.

<u>English</u>

Poetry has been the focus of English writing this week. The children have been writing poems capturing the core message of the class book 'Belonging'. This has given us an opportunity to review different rhyming patterns. However, we have been working hard on writing for effect, rather than for the sake of rhyme.

Topic/Science

The children really enjoyed sharing their Growing Up Timelines (the home learning from last week) and there were some wonderful photos and drawings of the children at the different life stages. The pictures of them as adults were particularly imaginative! Many thanks for all the support you must have given the children in completing this activity.

Alongside in Science this week, the children have been learning about the nutrition we need to stay healthy throughout our lives.

The children also continued their learning about the Victorian era. They have completed their research on aspects of Victorian life and they are now preparing posters to contrast their findings with life today.

Jewish Studies

This week we learnt about the fight between Yaakov and Esav and how we learn from that how important it is to listen to our parents. In our Chumash learning, we learnt that Avraham was 100 years old when Yitzhak was born.

<u>lvrit</u>

Year 4 carried on with the topic 'Where we live'. The key vocabulary includes: אַיַּמָה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים (Eifo anachnu garim – where we live) תַּחֲנַת אוֹטוֹבּוּס (Rechov – street) עִיר (Sifria – library) סוּבָּרְמַרְקָט (Supermarket) יִשְׂרָאֵל (Israel) גַּן שַׁעֲשׁוּעִים Shaashuim – playground) בֵּית סֵבֶּר (Beit sefer – school) בַּיַת (Bayit – house/home). This week we added a new preposition word: (leyad – near), to help to describe the location of a place.
