Dear Parents,

This week the children have been preparing and learning about Chanukah. They also participated in a Litter Pick with the Mill Hill Litter pickers, and contributed to making our local area a much tidier place!

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, the children practised the formal method of subtraction with two and three digit numbers. They learnt the process but also the reason why we borrow and exchange. They also used rounding and estimation to check their answers to calculations.

<u>English</u>

In English, the children identified features of a play script. They read through and acted out some famous play scripts. The children began to plan their own play script based on the class book Belonging. They thought about the beginning middle and end of the story and split these into scenes.

Other areas of the curriculum

The children looked at eating well and healthily. Children created an eat well plate thinking about the right amount of foods and nutrition in each food group. They discussed the difference between the nutrition that a baby, teenager and adult needs in order to survive.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies the children have been learning about what makes a Chanukiah kosher and they have started designing our own to make and bring home for Chanukah. They have also been signing some Chanukah songs. In Parasha they learnt about Yaakov's dream and how he learnt to deal with problems in a calm way and how to apply that to our own lives.

Year 3 carried on learning the topic הַמִשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלִי – My family. The class will be learning this topic throughout this half term. The words for this topic include:

Masculine), אָדי אָרוֹ (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), אָין לִי (Ein li – I don't have), יש אָי זאֹת? (Doda – aunt), דוֹדָה (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), בָּת דוֹדָה, (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).
