
Dear Parents,

English

In English, the children were introduced to the character of 'The Dark' in their class book. They understood that this character was not as scary as he seemed and actually just wanted to be Orion's friend and go on adventures with him.



Maths

This week, the class were introduced to the concept of tens and ones. They were able to look at 2-digit numbers and begin to understand that they can be identified as tens and ones. They were also introduced to a part-whole model, a visual

representation of how to split up a number.

Continuous Provision

The children have continued working on the following activities to enhance their learning this week:

Phonics: spinning a dreidel and reading the word it lands on

Jewish Studies

We continued with our theme of Chanukah. The children (and the Year 1 team) are extremely proud of how hard they have worked to make their clay Chanukiot and how the children have taken such pride in their work. Our Hebrew reading is coming on beautifully too and the children are so excited when they move up a level.

Ivrit

This week Year 1 learnt about Chanukah. In Ivrit we created sentences using the words we learnt: גֵר (Ner – candle), גֵר (Ner – candles), בָרוֹת (Matana – present) מַהָּנוֹת (Matanot – presents), חַנּבְּיָה (Chanukiah), חַנּוּכִיּוֹת (Chanukiah).

The class was excited to learn a new song for Chanukah בר לִי נֵר לִי (Ner li ner li – candle for me, candle for me) which you can find on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=m8zuD9zylxU

In English, the children will be finishing their class book.

In Maths, the class will consolidate their learning on place value.

In JS, Year 1 will be painting their Chanukiot and acting out the Chanukah story.
