Dear Parents,

The children have had an exciting week getting ready for Chanukah! They have been busy planning their Chanukah door and making their chanukiot.

#### Maths

In Maths, the children started to look at money. They recapped the different values of coins and converted different amounts between pound and pence. They used coins and other resources to help them with this. In CP, the children had to make different amounts of money using as many and as few coins as possible.

#### **English**

In English, the children revised the features of a play script during CP. They had to act out a famous play and think and write down features that made it a play script. The children also planned and wrote their own play script on the class book 'Belonging'. They thought about three scenes they wanted to include.

#### Other areas of the curriculum

The children started practising their song for the whole school Music concert next week which looks at being safe on the Internet. The children are excited to perform it. They also looked at different schools throughout different generations and began to compare the similarities and differences. It was interesting for them to look at what a Victorian classroom was like compared to their classroom today.

### **Jewish Studies**

This week in Jewish Studies the children have been learning about what makes a chanukiah kosher and they have started designing their own clay chanukiot to bring home. They have also been singing some Chanukah songs. They have also been revising their script letter formation through a dreidel game.

### <u>Ivrit</u>

This week Year 3 learnt about Chanukah. We have practiced the phrases: הֲנוּכָּה שָׁמֵחַ (Chanukah Sameach – happy Chanukah) מֵג שָׁמֵחַ (Chag Sameach – happy festival) with each other. The children created sentences using these words: סְּוּבְּנָנִינָה (Leviva- latke), סְּוּבְיבִּוֹת (Levivot- latkes), סְּוּבְּנָנִינָה (Sufgania – doughnut), אוֹבֶל (Ochel – eating, male), אוֹבֶל (Ochelet – eating, female), אוֹבֶל (Ohev – love, masculine), אוֹבֶל (Ohevet – love, feminine), רוֹאָה (Roe – see, masculine), רוֹאָה (Roa – see, feminine).

The class also learnt the song בָּאנוּ חֹשֶׁךּ לְגָרֵשׁ (Banu choshech legaresh – we have come to shoo away the darkness) which you can find on <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0BdV9Kwc0FQ">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0BdV9Kwc0FQ</a>
