Dear Parents,

This week the children have really enjoyed getting involved in learning related to their new topic 'Fashion'.

Maths

In Maths, the children were introduced to multiplication. They spent some time understanding multiplication as repeated addition and adding equal groups. The children specifically focused on this with the 3 times tables. The children used their reasoning skills to correct mistakes relating to grouping on questions and explained why they were incorrect. The children also made inferences on the front cover of the book. They justified their predictions by referring to the image on the front cover and the title of the book.

English

In English, the children look at making inferences. Our new book 'Bill's New Frock' looks at stereotypes between boys and girls. The children had to draw their representations of different professions and we discussed stereotypes and the similarities and differences between their drawings.

Other areas of the curriculum

The children were introduced to their new topic Fashion. They looked at different people from all over the world and the clothes that they were wearing. They thought about what that person might be like, where they might be from and any information they knew about what they were wearing. The children also began their new PE topic Dance. They learnt a variety of different movements that they had to work in pairs to complete.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies the children have continued following the lives of Rivka and Yitzhak. They have also recapped over the last few weeks Parashiot and have learnt about Yosef and his forgiving nature even after what his brothers did to him

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 carried on learning the topic הַמִּשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלִי – My family, combined with a new topic: Preposition. The words for this topic include:

קּפְּחָה (Mishpacha – family), אָמָא (Saba – grandfather), סָבְתָא (Savta – grandmother), אָמָא (Ima – mum), אָמָא (Aba – dad), אָחוֹת (Ach gadol – big brother), אָח קָטָן (Ach katan – little brother), אָחוֹת (Achot gdola – big sister), אָחוֹת קְטַנָּה (Achot gdola – big sister), אָחוֹת קְטַנָּה (Achot ktana – little sister), מִי זָה? (Mi ze? – who is it? Masculine), יֵשׁ לִי (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), יֵשׁ לִי (Ein li – I don't have), דוֹדָ (Dod – uncle), דוֹדָה (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), בָּת דוֹדָה (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).

The new preposition words the class will cover are: אַחָבִי ,לְפָנֵי ,מְתַּחַת, עֻל ,יוְבֵּ ,לְיַד which means: behind, in front, under, on, between and near.
