Dear Parents,

This week the children have really enjoyed getting involved in learning related to their new topic 'Fashion'. They loved all of the Science Week exploring and experimenting.

Maths

In Maths, the children have continued their learning about multiplication. They specifically focused on the eight times table and made equal groups. They looked at the relationship between multiplication and division and derived different facts when knowing either the multiplication or the division. They also moved on to solving missing number problems.

English

In English, the children continued to read the class book 'Bill's New Frock'. They learnt about summarising and summarised a section of the story in as few words as possible. The children also wrote character descriptions about the main character Bill and practised using a dictionary to define words that they weren't sure about.

Other areas of the curriculum

The children loved Science Week! There was a specific focus on Light and Dark. The children started off the week by thinking about what light and dark are and used 'feely bags' to see if they could discover what the object was without using their eyes or light. The children also looked at reflective light. They made predictions about what objects they thought would be the most reflective. They then tested a variety of different objects and ranked them on a scale of most to least reflective and drew a conclusion.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies the children started learning our first Perek and Passuk in Chumash and they are starting to follow the life of Avram. They also learnt about the Parasha of the week Shemot and Paroah's decree to throw all the Jewish babies into the Nile.

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 carried on learning the topic הַמִּשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלִּי – My family, combined with a new topic: Preposition. The words for this topic include:

מָשְׁפָּחָה (Mishpacha – family), אָמָא (Saba – grandfather), סָבְתָּא (Savta – grandmother), אָמָא (Ima – mum), אָה (Aba – dad), אָח גָּדוֹל (Ach gadol – big brother), אָח קָטָן (Ach katan – little brother), אָח קָטָן (Achot gdola – big sister), מִי זֶה (Mi ze? – who is it? (Achot gdola – big sister), אָחוֹת קְטַנָה (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), יֵשׁ לִי (Ein li – I don't have), יֵשׁ לִי (Yesh li – I do have), דוֹד (Dod – uncle), בָּת דוֹדָה (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), בָּת דוֹדָה (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).

The new preposition words the class will cover are: אַחָבִי ,לְפְנֵי ,מְתַּחַת, עֻל ,בֵּין ,לְיַד which means: behind, in front, under, on, between and near.
