Dear Parents,

Year 5 have been extremely busy scientists this week and have enjoyed all things science relating to science week.

English – Year 5 have taken a break from reading *Floodland* to focus on science in fiction this week. They have read extracts from *Gulliver's Travels* and discussed science in fiction. They have explored the genre and talked about how to put Science Jargon into their own piece of writing. Pupils planned their pieces of writing and wrote their own stories.

Maths – Year 5 have continued to look at Fractions this week. Pupils have explored how to add and subtract them using concrete, pictorial and abstract mediums. They have enjoyed answering fluency, reasoning and problem solving questions in order to master this objective.

Topic – Pupils have had a fantastic opportunity to delve into many practical experiments this week. We discussed materials and designed our own Mars Rovers. Pupils were able to choose materials and explain why their properties made them fit for purpose as a Mars Rover. Pupils explored the Science behind music in their music lesson where they were able to make their own ear gongs. Year 5 also looked at STEAM in art where we made exploding paint rockets. Each group was able to focus on an aspect of Science, Technology, Engineering, Art or Maths during the activity and report back on their findings. They also enjoyed creating Marble runs out of cardboard during their STEM activity. We also had an exploration of Lego We Do and will be focusing more on this next week too.
