## Dear Parents,

It has been a flow in Year 5 this week with our interdisciplinary River Week! Pupils have worked hard learning across maths, science, history, geography and English to find out all about The Docklands and The River Thames.

**English** – Year 5 have been busily writing reports on Norwich which relates to our class book *Floodland* by Marcus Sedgwick. Pupils have been working hard to find out lots of information about the place our story is set. They have identified the features required in their writing and began to plan out their piece of work.

**Maths** – Year 5 have continued to look at Fractions this week. We have looked at improper fractions and Mixed Numbers. We have completed a variety of problems with pictorial resources. Pupils have also had the opportunity to master the topic through reasoning and problem solving questions.

**Topic** – Pupils have explored The River Thames learning about its History. Pupils have reenacted a Frost Fair, learnt about Mudlarking and built their own bridges based on the bridges that are standing on The River Thames today. The pupils have explored The Docklands and its history in preparation for our trip next week.
