Dear Parents,

The children have been excited and engaged with their new topic 'Scavengers and Settlers'. It was great to share the research that the children have already done!

#### **Maths**

In Maths, the children tackled fractions! The children had already began to look at the idea that the fraction is part of a whole. The children found fractions equivalent to a whole. They used stem sentences to articulate what one whole was the same as. The children also looked at tenths. They learnt and discussed what a tenth represents and how many tenths make one whole. They represented this in many different ways.

# **English**

In English, the children were introduced to their new class book 'UG- Boy Genius from the Stone Age'. The focus for this week was predicting and inferring what the story was about from looking at the main characters and the front cover. The children also thought about and wrote their impressions of the main characters by looking at their facial expressions and body language.

## Other areas of the curriculum

The children were introduced to their new topic Scavengers and Settlers. A discussion took place about when the Stone Age was and about what people would have looked like during that time. The children discussed what their family members might have looked like in the Stone Age, referring to them as their ancestors.

The children also looked at rocks and their uses. They learnt about man made and the three types of natural rock (igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic). They then had the chance to define these terms and group different rocks into man-made and natural rock categories.

# **Jewish Studies**

The children have started learning the Purim story and the 4 Mitzvot of Purim. They learnt that Queen Esther hid her identity as a Jewish woman which ultimately saved the Jewish people from a terrible decree. They have learnt the reasons behind the 4 Mitzvot of Purim and they are also starting to plan their designs for our Mishloach Manot baskets.

#### **Ivrit**

Year 3 carried on learning the topic שֶׁלִּי הַמִּשְׁפָּחָה – My family, combined with a new subtopic: Preposition. The words for this topic include:

תּשְׁפָּחָה (Mishpacha – family), אָמָא (Ima – קּבָּת, אָבָּת, (Savta – grandmother)) אָבָא (Ima – mum), אָבָא (Aba – dad), גָּדוֹל אָח (Ach gadol – big brother), קָטָן אָח (Ach katan – little brother), אָחוֹת (Achot gdola – big sister), קָטָן אָח (Achot ktana – little sister), יְדָה מִי (Mi ze? – who is it? Masculine), יְדָּאָת מִי (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), לִי אֵין (Ein li – I don't have), יִי שַׁ (Yesh li – I do have), דוֹדָה בָּת (Dod – uncle), דוֹדָה בָּת (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), דוֹדָה (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).

The new preposition words the class will cover are: אַחָבִי ,לִּפְנֵי ,מִתַּחַת ,עֵל ,בֵּין ,לְיַד which means: behind, in front, under, on, between and near.
