The children loved hearing about their favourite characters in different stories. They also learnt about heroes and villains, which linked nicely with the story of Purim. The week continued with parents coming in to read to their children, which the children loved! Especially going in to their siblings classes for stories. They also liked it when we went into Year 3 for peer reading. The Nursery children loved seeing Miss Rich, and her class were so welcoming and kind. They buddied up and the Year 3 children read to the Nursery children.
