

Dear Parents,

Maths

In Maths this week, we have continued with the same topic as last week. We have solved division and multiplication questions mentally following different strategies as halving or doubling numbers. Then, the children were reminded of how to multiply 3 and 4-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers following the Grid method. Finally, we multiplied 2-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers following the long multiplication method.

English

In English, we carried on writing our play scripts which were based on the tale of 'The Considerate Hunter'. The children have edited their work and they have filled in a checklist with what they have included/not included in their play scripts. Last, we have discussed about pronouns and prepositions and we have completed some exercises involving these parts of speech.

Science

In Science, we have continued with our topic for this half term which is 'Sound'. The children have revised on how sounds are being produced and they have learnt that sounds can also travel through solids and liquids. They have been asked to create a comic strip and to write about what is happening when someone hits a drum.

Geography

In Geography, the children solved problems using the 8 points of compass and other relevant terminology.

Jewish studies

This week in Jewish Studies, we have reviewed the Purim story and have been making story boards. We have also been making our Mishloach Manot baskets which we are excited to give out on Purim. We have also been making Purim Hebrew word searches which we are going to swap with our friends and complete.

Ivrit

Year 4 carried on with the topic: ושתייה אוכל - Food and Drinks. The children are learning to name different foods and putting them into sentences. Some of the foods the children are learning to name are:

לימון (Limon – lemon) פיצצה (Pizza) ברוקולי (Broccoli) ביצה (Beitza – egg) תפוז (Tapuz – orange) תה (Te – tea) פסטה (Pasta) חמוץ (Humous) פיתה (Pitta) בננה (Banana) שוקולד (Shokolad – chocolate) פלאפל (Falafel) חלב (Chalav – milk) גבינה (Gvina – cheese) לחם (Lechem – bread) עגבניה (Agvania – tomato) מלפפון (Melafefon – cucumber).
