What an exciting week we have had this week! Year 5 enjoyed celebrating Purim and performing at the dance festival!

English – Year 5 have edited and reviewed their Traditional Tales this week. The children edited their own work, exchanged with a friend and then conferenced with Mrs Gishen to uplevel their work further. They then have written their final drafts which they are very proud of.

Maths – Year 5 have continued to look at decimals and place value this week. The children have multiplied and divided by 10, 100, 1000 exploring the pattern this has on place value and what it looks like on the place value grid. They have explored problems involving measurement and have adapted this to the real life scenario of planning a fun run in the playground.

Topic –In science the children continued to look at forces and conducted experiments in groups. The children continued with their Topic Fairground projects further practising the skillsets involved with group work.

Reminders -

The children must be reading their scheme books out loud every evening. Please ask them comprehension questions about the text they are reading and date and sign the blue diary each time. The children should also be reading their 'home' books as well. The school library books can be changed or renewed on Mondays or in Library Club on Wednesdays.

Please ensure your child has their blue diary each day. If they are being collected by someone else to usual, this must be recorded in the diary on the day.

All boys need a spare kippah in their tray and all children need a non-uniform cap in their tray too.

Children should be coming in to school in their PE kits on a Tuesday and Thursday morning. They should bring their school uniform in their PE bag to change into after PE.
