Dear Parents,

This week Year 2 have been working very hard and have been very productive!

Maths

In Maths this week we have been concluding our work on place value. We looked at tens and ones in two-digit numbers. The children explored this through a range of different resources. They also explored the language 'greater than' and 'less than' and have been using these terms to compare and order numbers. The children worked on representing numbers in different ways and have strengthened their understanding of writing numbers in numerals.

English

In English we have continued our work on 'Traction Man' by Mimi Grey. Our focus this week has been on describing Traction Man and predicting his magical powers. The children used an illustration to support their learning. They have also been looking at questions and exclamation marks and how to apply these correctly to different contexts.

Other areas of the curriculum

This week the children have continued their work on our topic 'The Magic Toymaker' and have explored materials in more detail. The children have been exploring different ways to describe objects and categorise them. The children did this through exploring a range of different toys. They began by comparing and describing them and then categorised them into a range of different groups. This week the children joined in the 2-minute silence on Remembrance Day. We explored what this meant and went into detail to understand the First World War. The children wrote acrostic poems about poppies and the contribution of young soldiers. They have also been working on their observation skills through drawing a teddy bear. The children have also reflected on how to improve their own drawings.

Jewish Studies

As it is Mitzvah Day 2020 on Sunday, the children in Year Two wrote letters for people in the Mill Hill community who are isolating or who need to be cheered up. We are delivering the cards to Mill Hill shul and they will distribute them to relevant people on Sunday. We also spoke about the importance of prayer; we see from the Parashah that Eliezer, who was the servant of Avraham, prays to Hashem to help him to find the right wife for Yitzchak. We explained that people all over the world pray to Hashem for His help when they are in need.

Ivrit

Year 2 carried on with the topic of בְּאַוִיר מֶזֶג (Mezeg Ha avir- the weather). Our new vocabulary includes: שָׁמֶשׁ (Geshem – rain) עָנָן (Anan – cloud) קָשֶׁת (Keshet – rainbow) שֶׁמֶשׁ (Shemesh – sun) (הַרְבָּה (Barak – lightning) מְעַט עֲנָנִים (Me'at ananim – little clouds) שָׁלֶג (Sheleg – snow) חַחַ (Cham – hot) (הַרָּבָה עֲנָנִים (Harbe ananim – a lot of clouds) הָלֶשֶׁם קַל (Geshem kal – light rain) הָּרְבָּה עֲנָנִים (Geshem chazak – heavy rain) מְנִנִים (Ananim – clouds) מְנִנִים (Meunan – cloudy) מָה הַמֶּזֶג אֻיַּר (Kaitz – summer) מְה הַמֶּזֶג אֻיַּר (Choref – winter) מְה וֹם יֵשׁ שֶׁמֶשׁ (Aviv – spring) הַיּוֹם אֵין עֲנָנִים (today there is sun) הַיּוֹם אֵין גְּשֶׁם (today there is sun) הַיּוֹם אֵין גָּשֶׁם (today there is no rain).
