Dear Parents,

We have had a busy week, continuing our learning about significant people.

English

In English this week the children have practised writing a biography. On 'No Pens Day', the children worked in groups using random objects as stimuli to create imaginative stories.

Maths

The children started off the week by using dienes equipment to represent subtraction calculations. They then progressed onto using the column method of subtraction before attempting word problems.

Topic

In Heads-Up the children continued to explore their emotions by having discussions with different classmates. In P.E the children continued practising different playground games.

Science

In Science, the children explored the purpose of switches. The children then made switches out of everyday objects and tested them in a circuit to see if they could make a bulb light up and turn off.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies the children were following the lives of Avraham and Lot in their Chumash learning and have been understanding how Avraham resolved the quarrel between their shepherds.

<u>Ivrit</u>

Year 4 carried on with the topic אֵיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים - 'Where we live'. The key vocabulary includes: אֵיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים (Eifo anachnu garim – where we live) אַיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ (Tachanat otobus – bus stop) עִיר (Ir – city) בְּחוֹב (Rechov – street) יָשְׂרָאֵל (Sifria – library) סוּפֶּרְמַרְקָט (Supermarket) יִשְׂרָאֵל (Israel) בִּית סֵפֶּר (Gan Shaashuim – playground) בַּית סֵפֶּר (Beit sefer – school) בַּיִת סֵפֶּר (Bayit – house/home).

Next week:
