We have had another great week in Year 3!

## **Maths**

In Maths, we learnt about length. The children measured different objects in cm and m. They compared different measures and they ordered them.

We revised on the 3 and 4 times tables and we started to learn the 8 times table. ## **English**

In English, we looked at our drawings with the inventions which can make life at school better. The children edited their work and they labelled it. They also wrote an explanation on their invention. They, then started to think and discuss about how they can present their work to Mrs Baron. They started to plan their letters to her.

The children learnt how to make their sentences longer using a variety of conjunctions. They continued practising the spellings from the Year 3 and 4 list with commonly misspelt words. The spellings for this week were: remember, answer, question, famous and favourite.

#### Science

In Science, we carried out an investigation about gravity. The children were observing different objects while they were falling on the floor. First, they predicted which of the objects would go down quickly and after having observed them, they wrote down the results.

## **Jewish Studies**

This week in Jewish Studies the children have been practising their lines and songs for the Chagigat HaChumash.

## <u>Ivrit</u>

Year 3 carried on with the topic מַּשְׁפָּחָה שֶׁלִי – My family. Masculine), אָרן לי (Mi zot? – who is it? Feminine), דוֹד (Dod – uncle), דוֹד (Dod – aunt), דוֹד (Ben dod – cousin, masculine), דוֹדָה (Bat doda – cousin, feminine).
