Dear Parents,

### English

The children were introduced to a wordless picture book and explored how meaning can be conveyed without the need for words. The images were then used as a stimulus throughout the week for various creative writing, drama and inference activities.

### Maths

The children looked at meters, centimetres, millimetres and how to convert between these units of measurements. They also revisited perimeter and had outdoor learning opportunities based on this area of learning.

### PΕ

In P.E the children continued to explore playground games. This week the children chose the games that were played and were encouraged to explain and lead the games to promote their confidence.

#### <u>Art</u>

The class learnt how to mix a skin colour using poster paints. They understood that in Art, no one has 'white' or 'black' skin, but rather various shades of brown. They started with white paint, adding some red, a little yellow and a dot of blue to create a light brown colour. They painted small streaks of paint on their arm and continued to add little dots of coloured paint to create the best skin colour for them.

### Science

In Science this week the children were introduced to buzzers and motors. The children predicted what the function of these components were before constructing a simple series circuit to explore the components functions.

### **Jewish Studies**

This week in Jewish Studies the children have been making their clay chanukiot and have been practising their Chanukah songs. They have also been focusing on reading for meaning in their Hebrew reading lesson.

# <u>Ivrit</u>

Year 4 carried on with the topic אֵיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים - 'Where we live'. The key vocabulary includes: אֵיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים (Eifo anachnu garim – where we live) שַּׁיבֹּה אֲנַחְנוּ תַּחְנַת אוֹטוֹבּוּס (Tachanat otobus – bus stop) יְיִי (Ir – city) רְחוֹב (Rechov – street) סְּבֶּרִיהָ (Sifria – library) סוּבֶּרְמַרְקָט (Supermarket) יִשְׂרָאֵל (Israel) בַּיִת סֵפֶּר (Gan Shaashuim – playground) בַּיִת (Beit sefer – school) בַּיִת (Bayit – house/home).
