Dear Parents,

We have had an exciting week preparing for Chanukah.

English

The children started learning from the book 'The Tinderbox', originally written by Hans Christian Anderson. They first looked at the image of the soldier and discussed what they thought the story was going to be about. They then read more of the story, learning about the witch that the soldier killed and discussing their opinions on this part of the story.

Maths

This week, the children revised multiplication. They looked at multiples of different numbers, as well as revising the use of arrays. They learnt the concept of calculations being 'commutative', meaning that the numbers can be swapped over but the answers will stay the same. They also took part in an activity to use multiplication to scale a recipe.

Science

In Science this week the children completed their topic of electricity by creating circuits and developing their knowledge of the components and their symbols.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies the children have been learning the story of Chanukah and the Maccabees. We learnt about the miracle of the battle and the miracle of the bottle. The children finished making their Chanukiot and are excited to light them for Chanukah.

Ivrit

Year 4 carried on with the topic אֵיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים - 'Where we live'. The key vocabulary includes: אֵיפֹה אֲנַחְנוּ גָּרִים (Eifo anachnu garim – where we live) אַיפֿה אֲנַחְנוּ (Tachanat otobus – bus stop) עִיר (Ir – city) חַוּבֶּר (Rechov – street) סָּבֶּרְיהָ (Sifria – library) בַּיִת סָבֶּר (Supermarket) בַּיִת (Israel) בַּיִת (Bayit – house/home).

Next week:

In English, the children will be continuing looking at the text 'The Tinderbox' by Hans Christian Anderson.

In Maths, the class will be continuing to revise multiplication and division.

In Jewish Studies the children will be learning how to spin the dreidel and will participate in lots of Chanukah activities.

- Practise the times tables.
