Reception had such a busy week! We have been getting excited using our new token system which is helping us to get ready for Year 1. This week the children have been learning about the differences between some transports that we use every day.

During Numeracy, the children have been continuing to count in twos, fives and tens. The children loved making

number lines and counting the Numicon. They have also been uploading their own work using Seesaw and enjoying being in charge of their own work.

The children have been writing lots this week! Their favourite writing task was when they were asked to write about their morning before school. We are continuing revising our Hebrew letters, this week we learnt Chet and Tet. We also learnt tet has a hole in its top and we found all the things around the classroom we could find that began with the 't' sound. I have assigned relevant games on JI Tap,
